GUIDELINES FOR OBTAINING AN OCCUPANT LOAD CERTIFICATE

The International Building Code requirement for Occupant Load Certificates reads, "Any room that is an <u>assembly</u> occupancy shall have the occupant load of the room or space posted in a conspicuous place, near the main exit or exit-access doorway from the room or space. Posted signs shall be of an approved legible permanent design and shall be maintained by the owner or authorized agent."

An <u>assembly</u> use is a building or portion of a building used for the gathering together of people for a common purpose, which could include such purposes as deliberation, education, instruction, worship, entertainment, amusement, drinking or dining, or awaiting transportation.
